The Florida Department of Health ("Department") received correspondence from San Felasco Nurseries, Inc., d/b/a Harvest's House of Cannabis ("Harvest") on December 17, 2020. In the correspondence, Harvest requests permission to make a third wholesale flower purchase of marijuana from Bill's Nursery d/b/a The Flowery ("The Flowery") due at its cultivation facility located at

The Flowery agrees to provide Harvest of marijuana with the following:

Harvest also states it has the option to purchase an additional marijuana from The Flowery. Harvest will provide a separate variance request for the future wholesale purchase. The Department approved Harvest to purchase marijuana from The Flowery on November 5, 2020 and on November 25, 2020.

The Department finds that Harvest has submitted proof of harvest failure and may move forward with a wholesale purchase from The Flowery pursuant to section 381.986(8)(c), Florida Statutes.

A party whose substantial interest is affected by this action may petition for an administrative hearing pursuant to sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes. A petition must be filed in writing and must be received by the Agency Clerk within twenty-one (21) days from receipt of this notice. The petition may be mailed to the Agency Clerk, Department of Health, 4052 Bald Cypress Way, BIN #A-02, Tallahassee, FL 32399-1703; hand delivered to the Agency Clerk, Department of Health, 2585 Merchants Row Blvd., Prather Building, Suite 110, Tallahassee, FL; or sent by facsimile to (850) 413-8743. Such petition must be filed in conformance with Florida Administrative Code Rules 28-106.201 or 28-106.301, as applicable.

Mediation is not available.

Failure to file a petition within 21 days shall constitute a waiver of the right to a hearing on this agency action.
